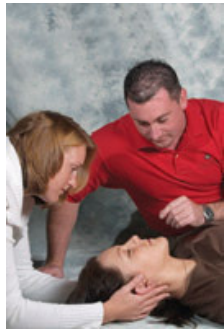

Designed to meet industry, business and government requirements, **Standard First Aid** is a modular course for those who want to learn more First Aid skills. The Standard level First Aid course is built on the same core and elective lessons as the Emergency level course.

### **Standard First Aid with CPR B**

**Cost: \$130 + GST** if registered at St. Johns

**Time: 8 am to 5 pm, 2 days**

Learn to recognize and provide intervention for life-threatening emergencies until medical aid arrives.

Topics include:

- Emergency Scene Management
- choking
- shock and unconsciousness
- severe bleeding, spinal injuries, fractures
- resuscitation skills for infants, children and
- one and two rescuer CPR for an adult casualty

Standard First Aid with CPR B includes the above hands-on lessons as well as a written exam.

**Minimum age:** 16 years

**Pre-requisite:** none

**Students receive:** First on the Scene: Student Reference Guide, certificate and pocket card  
St. John Ambulance Standard First Aid Certificate with CPR A valid for: 3 years
