## Helping to make every trip a round trip 2 DAY AVALANCHE COURSE FOR SNOWMOBILERS

THIS COURSE FOLLOWS THE GUIDELINES FOR COURSE CONTENT DEVELOPED BY THE CANADIAN AVALANCHE ASSOC.

This course is instructed by snowmobilers with emphasis on Safe travel, terrain recognition, and group safety in avalanche terrain

1 day classroom/1day in field

This two-day course will include 8 hrs. of classroom instruction followed a full day 8+ hrs in the field. Emphasis will be placed on recognition of avalanche terrain, avalanche formation, safe travel and survival strategy.

SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- **TRANCEIVERS 457 kHz only**
- SHOVEL/ must be appropriate for avalanche use
- AVALANCHE PROBE
- First Aid / Survival Kit Optional but recommended

### **IMPORTANT NOTES:**

1. Participants are required to stay with the instructor at all times, individuals who travel off independently causing group instruction or control problems may be required to leave the course. Group discipline is a given requirement.
2. It's best that the entire group you ride with takes the course. You want everyone in your group to be better than you at all of the skills afterall they will be the ones looking for you. If you are the only with the skills what's the sense? SledSmart, Have Fun, Live to go another day.
3. We have never had to cancel because of poor or cold weather. Be ready for all types of conditions, after all were sledders RIGHT
